## Residential Yard Debris Guidelines

Keeping Panama City Beach clean for our residents and visitors is a priority for the City. To that end, the City provides free street-side yard debris pickup for Panama City Beach residents.

The Street Department operates three debris trucks. Unfortunately, residents are not able to call and schedule a pick up. Drivers are continually rounding in the city limits so we ask for your patience Please be patient and we will get to you. They do not pick up household trash.

## Yard debris guidelines

The City of Panama City Beach picks up yard debris and yard trash free of charge from residential neighborhoods inside the city limits.

The City does **NOT**, however, pick up from commercial businesses, condominiums or apartment complexes. Professional landscape companies are responsible for their own yard trash created as a result of lot clearings and home renovations. Yard debris may not be dumped on empty lots.

All yard debris like leaves, grass clippings, pine cones, etc., **MUST BE BAGGED**.

City workers cannot pick up yard debris placed under power lines or tree limbs or atop utility boxes or near fire hydrants or any other obstacles.

## What is yard debris?

Yard debris and yard trash is defined as vegetative matter resulting from routine homeowner landscaping and yard maintenance. It must be home owner generated and includes:

- Grass clippings
- Shrub trimmings
- Palm fronds
- Tree branches
- Tree stumps
- Leaves
- Pine cones

The City will NOT pick up:\*


- Lumber
- Fencing
- Dirt/sand
- Furniture

\*Because the City utilizes Bay County's Steelfield Landfill, certain items cannot be picked up. The landfill operates a yard trash processing area; yard trash is ground into mulch and must be free of any foreign materials.
